



## Create the CAMPUS-AIR Profile

This step involves creating the base profile for the CAMPUS-AIR network that will be configured in the next section

1. Open **Network and Sharing Center**, either by:
  - a. Open the start screen and begin typing **Network and Sharing Center**; click the corresponding result
  - b. Right click on the network/wireless icon in the taskbar and select **Open Network and Sharing Center**
  - c. Open Control Panel, and navigate to Network and Sharing Center under the Network and Internet heading
2. In the **Network and Sharing Center** window, click **Set up a New Connection or Network**



3. Select **Manually Connect to a Wireless Network**
4. Enter the **network name** (CAMPUS-AIR) and select the **security type** (WPA2-Enterprise+AES) and click **Next**



5. Select **Change Connection Settings** to open the wireless network configuration window for CAMPUS-AIR. The settings expected are given in the following section of the guide.

## Modify Existing CAMPUS-AIR Profile

This step involves configuring the profile for the CAMPUS-AIR with your Student ID and Network Password

**Note:** If you are continuing from the previous page, proceed to [step 2](#). If you are updating your existing CAMPUS-AIR profile, or troubleshooting connection issues, then follow the steps below.

1. Opening a Wireless Profile properties window in Windows 8 is problematic. It has a known issue where it will not open the properties box allowing you to change settings, regardless of how you attempt to open it. You can try clicking on the network/WiFi symbol in the taskbar (by the time) and then **right** clicking on the CAMPUS-AIR network. You may see the selection to edit the configuration, if so, select it. Otherwise, select the option to **forget the network**. Follow the steps in the previous section to re-create the profile.
2. Click **Settings**, and match the settings in the window to the graphic on the next page
