

Operating System Independent Configuration Guidelines

The following settings are required for successful authentication with the CAMPUS-AIR Wi-Fi network. There are no other settings required beyond those in the table below required for the server to authenticate your device/account. This information can be used to configure any WiFi device, including Blackberry phones, Linux devices and Chromebooks.

CAMPUS-AIR Settings

Security Type: **WPA-Enterprise**

Encryption Type: **TKIP**

Phase 2 Authentication **PEAP & MSCHAP v2**

Other Settings:

- **Disable Certificate Validation**
- **802.1x User Authentication**
 - ONCAMPUS\100#####
 - Network Password

Note:

Windows 8 and 8.1 will only have WPA²-Enterprise and AES encryption available when making the configuration, but these settings will work.
